3.	Ro/ro ferry	The ro/ro ferry can carry up to 100 cars and 1,000 passengers, making it an efficient mode of transportation for both vehicles and people	<i>"We took ro/ro ferry to the island."</i>	Паром, перевозящий и груз и людей
4.	Hydrofoil	Boat with wing-like foils that lift it out of the water	<i>"The hydrofoil glided across the water."</i>	Судно на подводных крыльях (как «Ракета»)
5.	Catamaran	Boat with two parallel hulls	<i>"They sailed the catamaran along the coast."</i>	Катамаран

25.	Bridge	Area from which a ship is controlled	<i>"The captain commanded the ship from the bridge."</i>	Мостик
26.	Spa	Area for relaxation and beauty treatments	<i>"She enjoyed a massage at the ship's spa."</i>	Спа
27.	Radar	Device used for detecting objects at a distance	<i>"The radar detected other ships in the area."</i>	Радар
28.	Suite	Large, luxurious cabin	<i>"They stayed in a luxurious suite on the ship."</i>	Люкс
29.	Terrace	Outdoor area with a view	<i>"The terrace offered stunning views of the ocean."</i>	Терраса

31.	Playground	Area for children to play	<i>"Children played in the ship's playground."</i>	Детская площадка
32.	Pool	Swimming pool	<i>"Passengers relaxed by the pool on the deck."</i>	Бассейн
33.	Funnel	Pipe used for ventilation or exhaust	<i>"Smoke billowed from the ship's funnel."</i>	Труба
34.	Deck	Outdoor area on a ship	<i>"Passengers sunbathed on the ship's deck."</i>	Палуба
35.	Lounge	A room or area in a public space, such as a hotel or airport, where people can relax or wait for their flight or transportation	<i>"She relaxed in the ship's elegant lounge."</i>	Салон на корабле
36.	Stern	The back part of a ship or boat	<i>"The stern of the boat was painted blue."</i>	Корма корабля

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37.	Harbour	A place on the coast where ships can take shelter from rough water, load and unload cargo, and embark and disembark passengers	<i>"The harbour was filled with fishing boats."</i>	Гавань
38.	Marina	A dock or basin with facilities for loading and unloading boats, as well as for storing and repairing them	<i>"The marina was full of luxury yachts."</i>	Относится к причалу или бассейну с инфраструктурой для погрузки и разгрузки судов, а также хранения и ремонта их
39.	Port	A place on the coast where ships can load and unload cargo and embark and disembark passengers	<i>"The ship docked at the port to unload cargo."</i>	Порт
40.	Lighthouse	A tower or other structure with a powerful light at the top, located on or near the coast to guide ships and warn of danger	<i>"The lighthouse guided ships safely to shore."</i>	Маяк
41.	Quay	A platform or landing place on the edge of the water, typically on a river or canal, where boats can be moored for loading and unloading	<i>"The quay was lined with restaurants and shops."</i>	Причал, набережная; стенка (для причаливания судов)
42.	Starboard	The right-hand side of a ship or boat when facing forward	<i>"The starboard side of the ship faced the shore."</i>	Правый борт
43.	Wharf	A level quayside area to which a ship may be moored to load and unload cargo	<i>"The wharf was used to load and unload cargo."</i>	Пристань
44.	Embark a ship	To board a ship or boat	<i>"Passengers embarked the ship at the port."</i>	Садиться на корабль
45.	Disembark a ship	To leave a ship or boat	<i>"The crew helped passengers disembark the ship."</i>	Сходить с корабля
46.	Feel travel sick	To experience nausea or discomfort while traveling, especially by boat or car	<i>"She felt travel sick during the rough sea crossing."</i>	Чувствовать тошноту при путешествии
